The briefing will be open to all prospective candidates thinking of standing for election for the Parliamentary, District or Parish elections.

Details on the election timetable will be given together with a guide on the do's and don'ts of completing a nomination paper.

Nomination Papers and Nomination Registers will be available to take away on the evening

No requirement to register in advance.

Changes in law

(District and Parish)

Nomination Papers must now be **hand delivered** by the candidate or their appointed agent. Any nomination papers sent via Royal Mail will be invalid.

The date to allow candidates to withdraw from standing as a candidate has changed. This date is now at the same time and date as the deadline for nomination papers – 4pm on 9 April.

Nomination Paper - Informal Checking

It is advised that you allow enough time for your nomination paper to be informally checked before formal submission.

Early submission will allow plenty of time for checking and amending if required.

Postal Votes (approx. 11,500)

If you are a candidate at the election you are entitled to come to the opening of postal votes, however no tally sheets will be permitted.

Issuing Dates

The majority of Postal Votes will be issued on

23 April, 24 April, 27 April - 1st class

Opening Dates

30 April – 10-5pm 5 May – 10-5pm

6 May – 10-5pm 7 May – 10-5pm

7 May - 10pm at Verification, Holsworthy Sports Hall

All opening sessions will take place in the Committee Room, Riverbank House Bideford, unless stated.

The Verification and Counts

All ballot boxes from the Torridge and West Parliamentary
Constituency will be returned to Holsworthy Sports Hall, Well
Park, Holsworthy after the close of poll. All ballot boxes will
be verified on Thursday 7 May until the early hours of Friday
morning.

The Parliamentary Count will take place once all the Parliamentary ballots have been verified on 7/8 May and will be counted overnight.

District Count – this will begin at 2pm on Friday 8 May at Holsworthy Sports Hall, Well Park, Holsworthy

Parish Count – this will begin at 10am on Monday 11 May at Langtree Village Hall

The Verification and all counts will be ticket only events. Tickets will be sent out prior to the verification/count.
